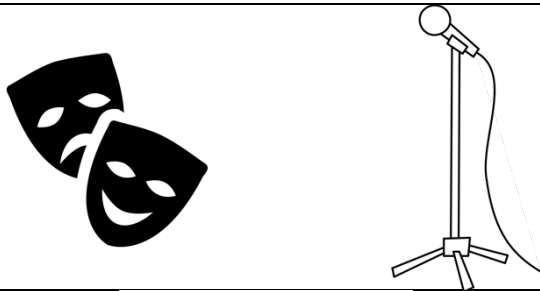

It is an outdoor **theatre performance at Bolton Gate Arts with acting, singing and puppets**



We will be **walking** around, outside altogether throughout the show



There will be some **seats** in each section if you need to sit down.



“Imprints: Tales from the New Wild” is an **inclusive** performance

It is a **relaxed and accessible performance.**



It is a show where you get to **walk through** different spaces outside, touch things, hear things, and talk to some of the actors.



There are some points of the show where a performer might talk to you

It is ok at any point in the show **to talk to a performer.**

It is ok to **not reply to a performer** if you do not want to.

It is okay if you prefer not to join in, and you'd prefer just to watch.



There will be loud noises, music and the performers will talk loudly and shout at some points during the show

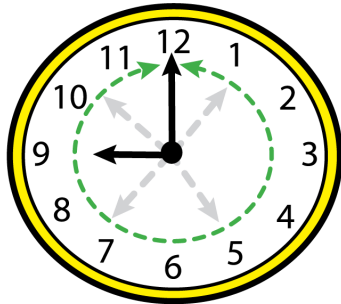


20 performers perform in Imprints Tales from The New Wild

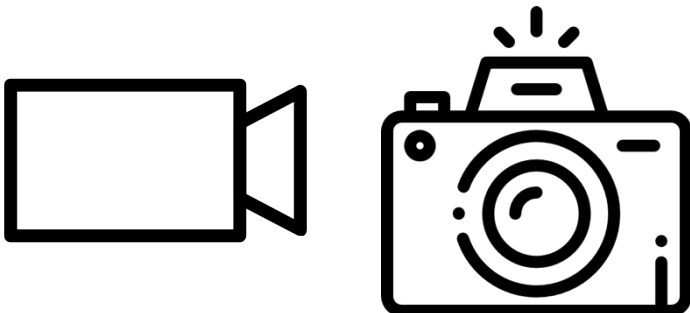


The **show** is performed at **Bolton Gate Farm**

The show will start in the **field** next to the **gravel car park**

You will see Emma, Peter and Kath there

At the **start** of the show we will hear a song, and meet The Oracle, Death and Megany and Diglet here



We will walk up the path together towards the market



We will meet some guards at the gate to the market

They will talk to us and ask us questions



The guards will let us into the market and give us a swan token to spend



In the market we will see lots of market stalls and you can spend your swan token



We will meet The Fortune Teller



We will meet Queen Wallaby



We will meet The Murderous Mrs Crow



We will meet The Green Knight here



We will go into Queen Wallaby's Lair and The Mermaid Pool
